PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE OVERVIEW

- Presbyterian College is led by 10th-year Head Coach Elton Pollock.
- The Blue Hose won two of three games against three different teams last weekend.
- Brad Zebedis leads the team with a .385 batting average, one homer, and seven RBIs.

CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson swept Maine last weekend by a combined score of 28-7.
- The Tigers average 7.8 runs per game and hit .329 with a .397 on-base percentage and 16 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 2.95 ERA, .261 opponents' batting average, 6.25 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and .972 fielding percentage.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson has four come-from-behind wins among its five total victories in 2014.
- Clemson leadoff batters of an inning have reached safely 50 percent of the time in 2014.
- Tiger pitchers have combined for five pickoffs in six games.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson averages 5,086 fans per date (6) in 2014, the eighth-highest figure in the nation (through games of February 23).
- Clemson has had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 20 straight seasons and a top-10 figure 12 years in a row (entering 2014).

HEAD COACH JACK LEGGETT BY THE NUMBERS

- Leggett was inducted into the **ABCA** Hall of Fame on January 3, 2014 in Dallas, TX.
- In his 35th overall year, he has 1,269 wins, 10th-most in Division I history and fifth-most among active coaches.
- His 892 wins as head coach at Clemson (1994-14) are sixth-most in the nation during that span.
- He has led Clemson to a winning ACC regular-season record 19 times in 20 seasons at Clemson.
- He has 231 top-25 wins, 125 top-10 wins, and 60 top-five wins as head coach at Clemson.

CROWNOVER SPEEDS UP

- Sophomore lefthander Matthew Crownover had "Tommy John" surgery in March of 2012, therefore he was not 100 percent as a freshman in 2013.
- His fastball has sped up in 2014, as evidenced by his nine strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched against Eastern Michigan on February 15.
- He is 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA and 13 strikeouts against only one walk in 10.0 innings pitched over two starts in 2014.
- He has a 9-3 career record and 2.25 ERA along with 58 strikeouts against 18 walks in 80.0 innings pitched over 17 outings (16 starts).

DUGGAR RIDING LAST SEASON'S WAVE

- Sophomore outfielder Steven Duggar is riding a 15-game hitting streak, which includes the last nine games of 2013 and the first six of 2014.
- During his 15-game hitting streak, he is 23-for-65 (.354).
- He is hitting .333 with two doubles, four RBIs, seven runs, and a team-high five stolen bases in 2014.
