CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- No. 10 Georgia downed Clemson 6-3 at SRP Park in North Augusta, S.C., on Tuesday night.
- The Tigers are averaging 5.9 runs per game and hitting .248 with a .369 on-base percentage and 24 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 3.20 ERA, .236 opponents' batting average and 2.31 strikeout-to-walk ratio and Clemson is fielding .976.

MIAMI OVERVIEW

- Miami is led by 25th-year head coach Jim Morris.
- Central Florida defeated the Hurricanes 4-0 on Wednesday. They are hitting .246 and have a 3.81 ERA and .964 fielding percentage.
- Isaac Quinones is hitting .317, Willy Escala is batting .306 and Freddy Zamora is hitting .302.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson has won seven of its eight weekend series in 2018.
- Clemson has hit 16 home runs in the last nine games.
- Eight different Tigers have started as the designated hitter in 2018.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 5,080 fans per home date (19), the fifth-highest figure in the nation and first in the ACC (through games of April 11).
- The Clemson record for average home attendance is 4,810 fans per date in 2007.
- Entering 2018, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 24 straight seasons and a top-15 figure 16 years in a row.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson (10-5) is in second place behind NC State (11-4) in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 10-5 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for second place behind NC State (11-4) and tied with Duke (10-5) and North Carolina (10-5).

SENIOR LEADERS

- Clemson has relied on four seniors in the heart of the lineup to achieve its 25-7 record this season.
- Patrick Cromwell, Robert Jolly, Drew Wharton and Chris Williams have been in the middle of the lineup for most of the season.
- They have combined to hit .252 with 23 doubles, a triple, 15 homers and 88 RBIs.
- Jolly is batting .267, Williams is hitting .264, Cromwell is batting .241 and Wharton is hitting .235.

BEER HAS 44 CAREER HOME RUNS

- Junior Seth Beer had 18 homers in 2016, 16 home runs in 2017 and has a team-high 10 homers in 2018, meaning he has 44 career homers.
- His 44 career homers are ninth most in Clemson history.
- He was one of 40 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is hitting .283 with 10 homers, five doubles, 25 RBIs, 29 runs, a .440 on-base percentage and a steal in 33 games in 2018.
- He has reached base via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 31 of the 33 games in 2018.
- He hit one homer in each game of the Georgia Tech series on March 9,10 and did the same in the Boston College series from March 29-31.
- In late March, he hit a home run in four straight games, the first Tiger to do that since Kris Harvey in 2005.
- He was named national player-of-the-Week by Perfect Game and ACC Player-of-the-Week on April 2, as he had four homers and 12 RBIs.
- He was named national player-of-the-month (March) by NCBWA after hitting .294 with eight homers, a double, 20 RBIs and 19 runs in 20 games.
- In his career, he is hitting .322 with 35 doubles, a triple, 44 homers, 148 RBIs, 137 runs and a .492 on-base percentage in 158 games.
- He has 154 career walks, fifth most in Clemson history, and his one walk every 3.47 at-bats is first.
- He has reached base via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 151 of his last 156 games with a plate appearance.
- He has reached via a hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in 95 of his 97 career games with a plate appearance against ACC (78) and SEC (17) teams.

CRAWFORD FINDING HOME ON WEEKEND

- Junior righty Brooks Crawford was a long reliever most of his first two seasons at Clemson, but he has become the Saturday starter in 2018.
- He is 3-1 with a 2.82 ERA, .259 opponents' batting average and 23 strikeouts against 10 walks in 38.1 innings pitched over eight starts.
- Clemson has a 7-1 record in his eight starts in 2018.
- He is holding opponents to a .143 batting average with runners in scoring position.
- In his career, he is 10-1 with one save, a 2.86 ERA and 71 strikeouts in 107.0 innings pitched over 51 appearances (10 starts).

CROMWELL GETTING ON BASE

- Senior Patrick Cromwell has emerged as one of Clemson's top offensive threats in 2018.
- He is hitting .241 with two homers, four doubles, 13 RBIs, 23 runs, a .377 on-base percentage and a steal in 33 games (30 starts).

- He has a .963 fielding percentage, committing only four errors in 107 chances, and has made many highlight-reel plays at third base.
- He hit the game-tying, solo homer in the ninth inning against Winthrop on Feb. 27, a game the Tigers went on to win.
- In his career, he is hitting .227 with four doubles, four homers, 18 RBIs and a .353 on-base percentage in 66 games (51 starts).

GILLIAM CLOSING THE DEAL

- Junior righthander Ryley Gilliam has been the team's closer each of the last two seasons and has a team-high five saves in 2018.
- He is 2-1 with a 1.29 ERA, .163 opponents' batting average and 20 strikeouts against nine walks in 14.0 innings pitched over 12 outings.
- He has not allowed any of his six inherited baserunners to score in 2018.
- In his career, he is 8-4 with nine saves, a 3.71 ERA and 86 strikeouts in 80.0 innings pitched over 54 appearances (six starts).

GREENE PROVIDING SPARK AT BOTTOM

- Junior infielder Jordan Greene has come on to become the starter at second base and has provided a spark at the bottom of the lineup.
- Clemson is 10-3 in his 13 starts and 7-1 when Greene is batting in the No. 9 spot in the starting lineup.
- He is hitting .310 with a double, four homers, nine RBIs, 13 runs, a .434 on-base percentage and three steals in 20 games in 2018.
- In ACC games, he is hitting .375 with a .529 on-base percentage and three steals in 10 games (eight starts).
- In his career, he is hitting .262 with 14 doubles, five homers, 34 RBIs, 56 runs and 11 steals in 117 games (91 starts).

HENNESSY LEADING ROTATION

- Sophomore lefthander Jacob Hennessy was a reliever as a freshman in 2017, but has become the Friday starter in 2018.
- He is 3-2 with a 2.42 ERA, .208 opponents' batting average and 42 strikeouts against 13 walks in 48.1 innings pitched over eight starts.
- He is holding opponents to a .148 batting average with two outs.
- In the first four innings in 2018, he has allowed 23 hits, six earned runs and nine walks with 30 strikeouts in 32.0 innings pitched.
- He earned the win against Boston College by allowing just one hit and no earned runs in 6.0 innings pitched on March 29.
- In his career, he is 5-3 with a 2.96 ERA and 79 strikeouts against 24 walks in 79.0 innings pitched over 34 appearances (eight starts).

HIGGINBOTHAM BACK ON THE MOUND

- Sophomore lefthander Jake Higginbotham was a mid-week starter as a freshman in 2016, but suffered an arm injury and missed all of 2017.
- He is 4-1 with a 4.05 ERA, .242 opponents' batting average and 30 strikeouts against nine walks in 40.0 innings pitched over eight starts.
- He returned to action against William & Mary on Feb. 18 and earned the win in 5.1 strong innings pitched, allowing just one run on two hits.
- He earned the win against No. 10 Dallas Baptist by allowing just five hits and no earned runs with seven strikeouts in 7.0 innings pitched.
- In his career, he is 7-1 with a 4.30 ERA and 58 strikeouts against 30 walks in 73.1 innings pitched over 16 appearances (15 starts).

NOTES

JOLLY HAPPY AS A SENIOR

- Robert Jolly is enjoying one of his best seasons as a senior in 2018. After being a catcher from 2015-17, he has moved to the outfield.
- He is hitting .267 with six doubles, a homer, 16 RBIs, 16 runs, 19 walks and a .385 on-base percentage in 31 games (30 starts).
- He is hitting .342 with runners on base and .368 with runners in scoring position.
- In his career, he is hitting .272 with 21 doubles, two homers, 51 RBIs, a .374 on-base percentage and three steals in 147 games (88 starts).

MARR HAVING STRONG FRESHMAN YEAR

- Redshirt freshman righthander Travis Marr has been one of the team's top long relievers in his second season in the program in 2018.
- He is 3-0 with a 2.767 ERA, .250 opponents' batting average and 25 strikeouts in 30.1 innings pitched over 12 appearances (one start).
- In his last nine appearances, he is 3-0 and has allowed just 15 hits and three runs (1.23 ERA) with 18 strikeouts in 22.0 innings pitched.
- He is holding opponents to 0-for-9 with four strikeouts against no walks with the bases loaded.
- He has allowed just eight hits and one run (0.54 ERA) in 16.2 innings pitched after the fifth inning.
- In his career, he is 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA and 27 strikeouts against 11 walks in 31.1 innings pitched over 13 appearances (one start).

MEREDITH ADDING SPEED TO LINEUP

- Freshman outfielder Kier Meredith made his Clemson debut at Notre Dame on April 7 after missing the first half of the season due to injury.
- He made an instant impact in the Notre Dame series, going 4-for-10 with a homer, triple, .571 on-base percentage and three steals.
- He is hitting .33 with a triple, homer, .556 on-base percentage and four steals in four games in 2018.

MILLER FILLING KEY RELIEF ROLE

- Senior righty Ryan Miller has been one of Clemson's top relievers in 2018 and has filled an important role.
- He is 2-1 with three saves, a 2.70 ERA, .227 opponents' batting average and 23 strikeouts in 30.0 innings pitched over 12 relief outings.
- He is holding opponents to a .143 batting average with two outs.
- He has 39 groundball outs compared to 23 flyball outs.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in relief to record the save in Clemson's win over No. 23 South Carolina at Greenville, S.C., on March 3.
- In his career, he is 3-1 with four saves, a 2.81 ERA and 34 strikeouts against nine walks in 41.2 innings pitched over 23 relief outings.

SPIERS MAKING THE JUMP

- Sophomore righthander Carson Spiers saw limited action as a freshman, but he has made a big jump as one of the team's top relievers in 2018.
- He has made a team-high 14 appearances, all out of the bullpen, and has three saves.
- He is 1-1 with a 2.89 ERA, .182 opponents' batting average and 19 strikeouts against eight walks in 18.2 innings pitched.
- He is holding opponents to an .094 batting average with runners on base.
- He has allowed only two of his 18 inherited baserunners to score in 2018.
- In his career, he is 1-1 with a 2.91 ERA and 22 strikeouts against eight walks in 21.2 innings pitched over 17 relief appearances.

- His cousin, Will Spiers, is the starting punter on the Tiger football team.
- His father, Michael Spiers, hit .301 with 16 homers, 110 RBIs and 32 steals in 184 games as a Tiger from 1988-91.
- His uncle, Bill Spiers, hit .325 with 17 homers, 119 RBIs and 60 steals in 173 games as a Tiger from 1985-87, then played 13 MLB seasons.
- His grandfather, Bud Spiers, hit .254 with seven homers and 44 RBIs as a Tiger from 1956-58.

WHARTON EMERGING IN FINAL SEASON

- Senior Drew Wharton entered the season with a career .220 batting average, no homers and 20 RBIs in 74 games (22 starts) over three years.
- With the departure of two outfielders from last year's team, he has made the most of his chance to contribute in 2018.
- He is hitting .235 with seven doubles, a triple, five homers, 27 RBIs and a .314 on-base percentage in 33 games (32 starts) in 2018.
- He hit three long balls, the first three of his career, in the series against No. 10 Dallas Baptist in February.
- He hit a walkoff triple in Clemson's 8-7 win over No. 23 South Carolina on March 4.
- In his career, he is hitting .228 with 10 doubles, a triple, five homers, 47 RBIs, 22 runs and five steals in 107 games (54 starts).

WILLIAMS POWERING TIGERS

- Chris Williams was drafted in the 31st round in 2017, but chose to return for his senior season.
- He is one of the team's best power hitters and has seen most of his action at first base in 2018, but has also played at catcher.
- He was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List in March.
- He is hitting .264 with six doubles, seven homers, 32 RBIs, 27 runs, a .354 on-base percentage and a steal in 33 games in 2018.
- He is hitting .333 with runners on base and .351 with runners in scoring position.
- In his three-year career, he is hitting .256 with 25 doubles, 29 homers, 121 RBIs, 90 runs and five steals in 139 games (127 starts).

FOUR TIGERS IN THE MAJORS IN 2018

- Former Tigers Daniel Gossett, Dominic Leone, Brad Miller and Tony Sipp have all played at least one MLB game in 2018.
- Gossett is in his second season, Leone is in his fifth season, Miller is in his sixth season and Sipp is in his 10th season.
- Gossett, who had a 23-9 career record at Clemson, made his major league debut with the Oakland Athletics in 2017.
- Leone, who had a 16-8 career record at Clemson, made his major league debut with the Seattle Mariners in 2014.
- Miller, the 2011 ACC Player-of-the-Year, hit .339 with 36 doubles, eight triples, 16 homers, 135 RBIs and 46 steals in 191 games as a Tiger.
- Sipp batted .280 and had a 2-2 pitching record for the Tigers in 2004.
